July 10, 2017

Present during the meeting were Commissioners Hoagland, Merrick and Aberasturi, Clerk Barkell, Deputy Clerk Russell, Assessor Endicott, Treasurer Richards, Planning and Zoning Director Huff, Road and Bridge #3 Supervisor Jewett, Juvenile Probation Supervisor Cardenas, Richard Tena with Suburban Propane and Sean Chaney with The Owyhee Avalanche.

In old business Commissioner Hoagland made a motion to approve the 2018 Retail Liquor License #11 to Pairadice Café, LLC (transfer from Caba's Restaurant and Lounge). Seconded by Commissioner Merrick. Motion carried.

Commissioner Merrick made a motion to set the agenda as presented. Seconded by Commissioner Hoagland. Motion carried.

Commissioner Merrick made a motion to approve the minutes from the July 3, 2017 meeting. Seconded by Commissioner Hoagland. Motion carried.

Commissioner Merrick made a motion to approve a Certificate of Residency to the College of Southern Idaho for student #2017-107. Seconded by Commissioner Hoagland. Motion carried.

Commissioner Merrick made a motion to place a lien on Indigent and Charity case 17-30. Seconded by Commissioner Hoagland. Motion carried.

At 9:45 a.m. Richard Tena with Suburban Propane presented a proposal to the Board for a fixed, year-long rate of \$1.25. The Board will take this proposal under consideration and get in contact with the current propane provider and offer them a chance to compete before making a decision.

At 10:30 a.m. the departmental quarterly reports were presented. Present were Assessor Endicott, Treasurer Richards, Planning and Zoning Director Huff, Road and Bridge #3 Supervisor Jewett (earlier in the meeting), Juvenile Probation Director Cardenas. Indigent and Charity Clerk Evans, Recording Clerk Peterson, Building Inspector King, Road and Bridge #1 Supervisor Rittenhouse and U of I Extension Office Educator Jensen submitted reports while not present.


Commissioner Hoagland made a motion to approve the temporary increase from a 1-mile radius to a 2-mile radius of residences able to testify in the proposed Wilson Creek Cattle Feeders expansion CAFO Conditional Use Permit. Seconded by Commissioner Merrick. Motion carried.

Commissioner Hoagland made a motion to approve the temporary increase of a 2-mile radius of property owners to be noticed for the proposed Wilson Creek Cattle Feeders expansion CAFO Conditional Use Permit. Seconded by Commissioner Merrick. Motion carried.
