- At Fair, decorating may be done throughout the day on Tuesday (both in the Armory and the livestock barns); however, **there can be no decorating in the livestock barns between 4:00 and 8:00 p.m.** Sheep and Goats will get priority entrance at the gates (Sheep at the west gate and Goats at the east gate) on Tuesday so they can get unloaded and ready for weigh-in Tuesday night, 6:00-8:00 p.m. There will be a Fair Board member at the gate to assist with traffic flow. Decorating must be completed by 10:00 p.m. and the west gate for livestock entry will be closed for the night at 11:00 p.m.
