

# **Owyhee County Fair 4-H and FFA Junior Livestock Sale**

Businesses or individuals may help in one or more of the following ways:

1. Purchase a whole animal and enjoy top quality meat (buyer pays for harvest, cut and wrap); OR
2. Support (re-sale) - pay the difference between floor price and your bid All market livestock sale animals will be sold on a "per head" basis. For example, if the floor price is \$100 and the bid price is \$400, the buyer pays the difference of \$300 and the animal is sold to a re-sale buyer for the floor price; OR
3. Flat amount (add-on) - designate an amount of support for a youth.

We appreciate your support of our 4-H and FFA youth with their projects in:

- ◆ BEEF (1,100 lbs. minimum)
- ◆ SWINE (230 lbs. minimum)
- ◆ SHEEP (110 lbs. minimum),
- ◆ GOAT (65 lb. minimum at initial weigh-in and must have a minimum ADG of .30 lbs. during the feeding period at final weigh-in).

Buyers will:

- ◆ receive a certificate;
- ◆ be listed in newspaper advertisements; and,
- ◆ be listed in the fair book next year.



- ALL ADD-ON'S MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY PAYMENT. You may mail your add-on form and payment after the sale. We will accept add-on donations until August 31. We will not bill for add-on donations unless they are from an individual or company that also purchased an animal at the sale.
- Add-on donations will be awarded ONLY to youth who have completed market livestock projects that go through the Junior Livestock Sale. Any add-on donation not awarded to an individual youth due to incompleion of 4-H/FFA Junior Livestock requirements will be refunded to the donor.
- A commission of 3% or less for beef (1.5% in 2013; 1% in 2014; 1% in 2015), and 4% or less (2.75% in 2013; 2.5% in 2014; 2.5% in 2015) for sheep, goats and swine will be deducted from the gross sale amount and all add-on donations.
- All 4-H and FFA members, organizations and contributors involved with the sale are strongly encouraged to consult their tax advisors regarding taxable income and charitable contributions.
