Commissioner Merrick called the meeting to order. Commissioner Aberasturi called for an executive session pursuant to Idaho Code 67-2345(1)(a) on a personnel issue. Commissioner Hoagland seconded the motion. Hoagland-aye, Aberasturi-aye, Merrick-aye. No action was taken.

Commissioner Hoagland made a motion to send a letter of intent to the Owyhee Soil Conservation District approving \$2,500 for fiscal year 2013 (June 30, 2013 to July 1, 2014). Commissioner Aberasturi seconded the motion. Motion was unanimous.

A mediation hearing on a Silver City matter between Fred and Carol Chadwick and Roger Nelson was held, with Jim Desmond as the acting Hearing Officer. Commissioner Hoagland recused himself. The mediated issue was an alleged zoning violation in Silver City. Testimony was given by Carol Malmberg-Chadwick property owner, Roger Nelson property owner, and Bill Statham, Chairman of the Historic Preservation Commission. After consideration of testimony, Commissioner Aberasturi made a motion to approve the Settlement Agreement between both parties, which orders a survey to be completed establishing which property the outhouse is located on. Commissioner Merrick seconded the motion. Motion carried.
