April 23, 2018

Present during the meeting were Commissioners Aberasturi, Hoagland and Merrick, Clerk Barkell, Deputy Clerk Russell, Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Blocksom, Prosecuting Attorney Emery, Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Dickinson, Treasurer Dygert, Assessor Gruenwald, Natural Resources Director Desmond, and Todd Kleppinger with the Owyhee Avalanche.

At 8:36 a.m. the attorney legal staffing portion of the meeting was held. Commissioner Merrick made a motion to approve (2) certificates of residency to the College of Western Idaho for students 2018-151 and 2015-152. Seconded by Commissioner Hoagland. Motion carried.

Commissioner Merrick made a motion to place a lien on Indigent and Charity cases; 18-10, 18-12 and 18-13. Seconded by Commissioner Hoagland. Motion carried.

Commissioner Merrick made a motion to approve Indigent and Charity case 18-10. Seconded by Commissioner Hoagland. Motion carried.

At 9:45 a.m. Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Dickinson gave the official oath and was sworn in.
