Commissioner Merrick made a motion to approve Indigent and Charity case 19-06. Seconded by Commissioner Aberasturi. Motion carried.


Commissioner Merrick made a motion to approve Indigent and Charity case 19-07. Seconded by Commissioner Aberasturi. Motion carried.
