Present during the meeting were Commissioner Hoagland, Merrick and Aberasturi, Clerk Barkell, Deputy Clerk Russell, Treasurer Dygert, Sheriff Grant, Indigent and Charity Clerk Evans, Natural Resources Director Desmond, Fairgrounds Manager Loucks, Bill Pastoor with Westowns Disposal and Todd Kleppinger with the Owyhee Avalanche.
