Present during the meeting were Commissioner Hoagland, Commissioner Aberasturi and Commissioner Merrick, Clerk Barkell, Deputy Clerk Russell, Deputy Clerk Yoshikane, Treasurer Dygert, Assessor Gruenwald. Commissioner Merrick made a motion to set the agenda as presented. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Aberasturi and carried.

Commissioner Merrick made a motion to approve the minutes from the December 7, 2020 meeting. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Aberasturi and carried.

Commissioner Merrick made a motion to approve the letter to be sent to Simplot re “Road maintenance issues in Owyhee County”. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Aberasturi and carried.

Commissioner Merrick made a motion to approve a letter to be sent to Idaho Conservation League and The Wilderness Society re “Road maintenance issues in Owyhee County”. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Aberasturi and carried.

Commissioner Merrick made a motion to approve the transferring of the liquor license from Logan’s Market to M&W Market in Marsing. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Aberasturi and carried.

Commissioner Merrick made a motion to approve the Treasurer’s tax cancellation on Parcel No RP04N06W256631, Homeowners Exemption fee of \$770.68 Motion was seconded by Commissioner Aberasturi and carried.

Commissioner Merrick made a motion to approve the fee reduction for rezoning applications to \$1500. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Aberasturi and carried.

Commissioner Merrick made a motion to table the snow removal bid from Bush Excavation, LLC. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Aberasturi and carried.

Commissioner Merrick made a motion to approve the lease of a VersaLink C405 Color Laser Multi-Function Printer and repair services for the Prosecutor’s office with Boise Office Equipment at \$99.74 a month for 60 months. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Aberasturi and carried.

Commissioner Merrick made a motion to approve the purchase of two Model DS200 voting machines through Elections Systems and Software for \$27,135.50. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Aberasturi and carried.


