Commissioner Aberasturi motioned to approve the Stericycle/Shred-it Agreement with the Chairman's signature for the Board. Seconded by Commissioner Hoagland. Motion carried.

Commissioner Aberasturi motioned to approve Certificate of Residency 22-33 for College of Western Idaho. Seconded by Commissioner Hoagland. Motion carried.

Grand View Ambulance – Terry Carothers and Pam Dugger spoke about the internal restructuring that has taken place with Grand View Ambulance, partially due to financial hardship. The ambulance service is hoping to be able to start billing for runs by October of this year. Terry requested \$10,000 in financial support from the County until revenue from billing can take effect.

Commissioner Aberasturi motioned to approve a one-time financial assistance in the amount of \$10,000 to Grand View Ambulance. Seconded by Commissioner Hoagland. Motion carried.

Engineer Cook spoke about two properties in the area for increasing the courthouse septic lagoon size; the two property owners will be asked. Commissioner Aberasturi will speak with Boise BLM during the meeting later about purchasing a small piece of land in the event that there is not other option. Discussed setting a bid window for well drilling. Commissioner Aberasturi gave update on weed notice from city of Homedale on County property in city limits and spoke about doing a property swap with two parcels by the County fairgrounds. Fairgrounds CXT bathroom door floor dusters were causing an issue with closing; contractor removed them for during the fair, then returned to replace them for proper door closing.

Met with Boise BLM for monthly coordination meeting.


There being no further business the meeting was adjourned.
