The net bond cost estimated to be repaid over the life of the bonds, based on the anticipated interest rate is \$8,661,631, calculated as follows: \$8,250,000 principal, plus \$3,618,500 in interest for a total bond cost of \$11,868,500, less \$3,206,869 received in estimated bond levy equalization payments and/or school district facilities funds. The term of the bond will not exceed 20 years.
