
At 9:45 A.M. P&Z Director Huff presented on the Comprehensive Plan update. They will be setting up a table at the upcoming Outpost Days at the Murphy Museum to help share information to the public. Director Huff reported that P&Z will hold a kickoff meeting, sub-committees will be formed and many public meetings will be held across the county to take public input. She anticipates the process will take approximately 12 to 15 months. She wants to remind the public that this plan is an organic long term plan that will take the county into the future and they should be watching their mail boxes for updates.

At 10:00 A.M. Joe Barton, Paragon Consulting presented the road analysis for Trout Creek and Pleasant Valley roads. Mine is planning on starting up in 2027, so we will need to have the road done in 2026. Next step is to schedule a meeting with Integra and make sure the budget includes the engineering costs in FY2025.

At 11:00 A.M. The Board met with the Boise District Bureau of Land Management.
