What is a Comprehensive Plan?

- A long-range policy document guiding growth, development, and decision-making in our community.
- Establishes a vision for the future, ensuring sustainable and orderly development.

Why is it Long-Range?

- Covers a 20–25-year period.
- Provides a stable framework for long-term development, with flexibility for adjustments as community needs change.

A Working Document

- Periodically updated to reflect new data, trends, and public input.
- Adapts to evolving circumstances and new information.

The Need for a Comprehensive Plan

- Guidance: Helps direct growth and development systematically.
- Coordination: Integrates transportation, housing, and land use.
- Sustainability:
 Promotes responsible and economically viable growth.

- Community

Transparency in the Planning Process

- Open Process:
 Activities and
 decisions are
 conducted openly.
- Accessibility:
 Documents and
 meetings are available
 to the public.
- Accountability:
 Regular updates and feedback maintain trust and engagement.

The plan with maps, charts, and reports shall be based on the following components as they may apply to land use regulations and actions unless the plan specifies reasons why a particular component is unneeded.

- Land Use
- Transportation
- Housing
- Economic Development
- Public Services
- Natural Resources
- Recreation
- Hazard Mitigation
- Property Rights:
- School Facilities and Transportation
- Community Design
- Agriculture
- Implementation
- National Interest Electric Transmission Corridor
- Public Airport Facilities

The plan shall consider previous and existing conditions, trends, compatibility of land uses, desirable goals and objectives, or desirable future situations for each planning component.
