Owyhee County is currently seeking an Emergency Manager to lead and oversee emergencies in Owyhee County. Essential functions include but are not limited to the following:

- Prepares, coordinates and administers the County's disaster response system and plan;
- Coordinates emergency services to effectively respond and direct recovery actions in the event of an emergency;
- Plans, develops and establishes procedures, methods, and techniques for disaster and emergency response;
- Works closely with City, County, State and other officials to coordinate emergency response services;
- Ensures that plans, procedures, supplies and equipment are readily available for emergency situations;
- Maintains records, documentation, and logs, including materials, tools, supplies, and equipment for emergency response;
- Manages the Homeland Security Grant Program, Emergency Management Performance Grant and other related County grants;
- Facilitates and supports a multi-year training and exercise plan to meet federal compliancy requirements;
- Performs public relations functions to create awareness and educate the public on issues relative to emergency services;
- Serves as advisor and/or liaison to various local and state boards, committees, and commissions representing the County's interests in emergency and disaster planning and services;
- Files and maintains all TIER II reports for agencies/industries
