**SCHOOL SUPPLEMENTAL LEVY ELECTION  
GLENN'S FERRY JOINT SCHOOL DISTRICT

The purposes for which the proposed levy revenues will be used and the approximate amount of levy funds to be allocated for each use are as follows:

**QUESTION:**

Shall the Board of Trustees of Glens Ferry Joint School District #192, Elmore & Owyhee Counties, Idaho, be authorized and empowered to levy a supplemental levy, as permitted by Idaho Code §33-802(3), in the amount of \$390,000 (Three Hundred Ninety Thousand Dollars), per year for two (2) years commencing with the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2026 and ending June 30, 2028 for the purpose of financing any lawful expenses of maintaining and operating the schools of the District; all as provided in the Resolution of the Board of Trustees of Glens Ferry Joint School District #192 adopted on March 11th, 2026.

"The estimated average annual cost to the taxpayer on the proposed levy is a tax of \$63.00 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, per year, based on current conditions. Currently, the District collects a supplemental levy that costs \$63.00 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, and the current levy will expire on June 30, 2026, so the proposed levy, if approved, produces a net increase of \$0.00 per \$100,000 based on current conditions."

**THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF

TO LEVY A PERMANENT OVERRIDE  
TAX LEVY COMMENCING THE  
DISTRICT'S FISCAL YEAR 2026**

This ballot poses one question.

Shall the Board of Commissioners of the Homedale Highway District, Owyhee County, Idaho, be authorized and empowered to increase the Homedale Highway District budget with a permanent override levy for Idaho Code §40-801 (1)(a) property tax levy for the construction and maintenance of highways and bridges not to exceed the sum of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars [\$150,000.00] beyond the amount authorized by Idaho Code Section 63-802 (1)(a) commencing for the fiscal year 2025-2026 and then established as the base amount for all subsequent fiscal years as authorized by law.

The estimated average annual cost to the taxpayer on the proposed \$150,000 levy override would result in an estimated \$48.38 per \$100,000 of assessed value per year, based on current conditions.
